
- I. Why profile the uninsured population in NV? Tailored interventions/legislation




NUMBER AND PERCENT OF UNINSURED PEOPLE IN NEVADA


PERCENT UNINSURED (ALL AGES), BY STATE, 2019






PERCENT UNINSURED IN NEVADA (ALL AGES), BY COUNTY,

THE UNINSURED POPULATION IN NEVADA, BY AGE COHORT,






THE UNINSURED POPULATION IN NEVADA, BY SEX, 2019






THE UNINSURED POPULATION IN NEVADA, BY RACE, 2019






THE UNINSURED POPULATION IN NEVADA, BY ETHNICITY, 2019




