Submitted Policy Recommendations to be Reviewed by the PPC



Solicitation of Recommendations (SOR)

As of 6/14/24, PPC received 26 submissions with recommendations.

- 12 related to insurance and increasing reimbursement rates
 - Of those, 8 recommendations directly addressed Medicaid
- 9 related to access to care
- 7 related to interstate licensure and reciprocity
- 6 related to reducing administrative barriers related to onboarding, training, and licensure requirements
- 5 related to offering loan forgiveness and/or tuition assistance
- 4 related to offering competitive compensation and incentive packages
- 4 related to monitoring the effectiveness of new and existing programs

Executive Order

The Executive Director of the PPC shall support commission members in reviewing available data and national best practices to develop recommendations for:

- (a) Attracting and retaining talent to address health-care workforce challenges in urban and rural communities;
- (b) Improving access to primary care and public health services;
- (c) Removing unnecessary state administrative hurdles to recruiting and retaining health-care workers;
- (d) Identifying sustainable funding strategies for strengthening the state's health-care workforce, which includes supporting competitive Medicaid reimbursements;
- (e) Ensuring recommended strategies for increasing provider reimbursement are based on payment methodologies that incentivize and reward for better quality and value for the taxpayer dollar; and
- (f) Identifying strategies for evaluating new and existing state investments in efforts to improve the capacity and size of the state's health-care workforce.



Commissioner Ideas

EO Section A

Improve recruitment and retention strategies to increase physician diversity.

Use incentives (stipends, loan repayment, scholarships, etc.) to increase provider supply in rural and underserved communities

Reduce/cap the amount of interest issued by insurers on medical education loans.

Enact Licensure Compacts and Reciprocity

Remove intrusive mental health questions from health care licensing and credentialing applications

Request health care licensing boards report on certain metrics and be held accountable for application processing times, etc.
